August 3, 2004 - Hessler's Pub

A brief Board Meeting preceded the business meeting. Several topics were covered:

- 1. For each member to vote at our club election in November, it will be necessary to pay Club dues for next year which will be \$55.
- 2. The board reviewed the club calendar and accepted Rick Frierdich's suggestion for an event on August 21, "We've Gotcha' Covered Poker Run".

President Ron Huch called the meeting to order at 7:05 P.M. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all. All club officers and chairpersons were introduced. Jim Wand was in attendance representing our club sponsor, Route 66 Chevrolet dealership in Pacific, MO.

Treasurer's Report by Fran Wienstroer

A motion was made by Jerry Fain, seconded by Jeff Craig to accept the Treasurer's Report as published in the monthly newsletter.

Secretary's Minutes by June Huch

It was incorrectly stated in the July minutes that we had a new member. A membership application was given to a guest attending the meeting in August, but it had not been returned to Judy. A motion was made by Carl Ballinger, seconded by Sharon Ballinger to accept the minutes as corrected.

Membership Report - Judy Lee

- 1. Judy announced that currently we have 23 primary members plus 18 associate members and two mail only members (Armynta Craig's sisters and their husbands).
- 2. August birthdays were announced (Jerry Craig and Carl Ballinger) and Karen and Mike Price are celebrating their 8th wedding anniversary. The birthday goodies were brought in by Theresa Luebcke.

NCM Report – Our NCM Ambassador, Sharon Ballinger, has tickets to sell for the Labor Day raffle for a 2005 Corvette Coupe – cost is \$10 each. She also has tickets for the last 2004 C5 Corvette Coupe at \$25 each. If anyone is interested, it is possible to purchase raffle tickets at \$100 each for the "Build your own C6 Coupe". She is suggesting that for anyone who is visiting the Corvette Museum, to walk through the gift shop as there are numerous items of interest. Fran and Mary received through the club post office box the Club plaque from the National Corvette Museum. Ron Huch will display the plaque at the front table at each of our club meetings. Corvette Museum pins will be raffled off tonight after the 50/50 drawing.

NCCC Governor's Report - Carl Ballinger

OLD BUSINESS

- 1. Club shirts- See Judy Dooley to purchase a club shirt, jacket, etc.
- 2. Static cling windshield stencils (\$12 a piece) See Ron Huch
- 3. Static cling logo decals See Ron to purchase a decal cost is \$5 each and the proceeds go to the General Fund.
- 4. Club Logo Patch Marty has purchased these from Midwest Monograms and has them available at tonight's meeting. See Marty if interested Cost \$12 each.
- 5. Marty Dooley and Fran Wienstroer will be visiting the Route 66 dealership in the near future about being our club sponsors for next year. Jim Wand attended the meeting and expressed an interest in continuing on with the sponsorship for next year. A letter on club letterhead will be prepared for the dealership to review before the end of this year.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. The club Christmas Party will be held at Harry's West on Saturday, December 4 from 6pm to? Cost per couple is \$50 pay Marty Dooley before the November meeting.
- 2. It was announced that the Board has decided to table any fund raisers until next year.
- 3. By next month, Ron will be contacting several people to serve on the Nominating Committee for 2005 Club Officers. An announcement will be made at the October meeting of who will be running for office and additional nominations can come from the floor. The election of all officers will be handled in November (President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Membership Chairman and Sergeant at Arms.) We'd like to see two people run for each office.
- 4. At the Christmas Party, all members will be recognized for each event they have sponsored

- this year.
- 5. The Club By-Laws will remain the same until the end of this year. The only change will be in the amount of dues to be paid next year.
- 6. Club Picnic Marty asked for volunteers to sponsor a club picnic. Mary and Fran Wienstroer have volunteered to plan this event (Fall Color Tour) on Sunday, October 31. More details will follow.
- 7. After much discussion, it was decided to discontinue publishing the monthly Treasurer's Report on the club website, but that the Club Treasurer will read the report each month in full detail. The September newsletter will contain the spreadsheet showing monthly disbursements and income.
- 8. Due to ongoing conflicts with another club in the St. Louis Area, it was decided by the Board for the time being to discontinue promoting that club's event in our newsletter and on our club website. This decision does not apply to other club's in the St. Louis area.
- 9. Club members are encouraged to follow a protocol for scheduling events:
 - A written or verbal description of an event is to be given to the Activities Chairman or Vice President.
 - Vice President takes the suggestion to the Board for review and approval of date.
 - Board approves and advises Activity Chairman of approved event.
 - Activity Chairman advises Webmaster to post event on website.
- 10. The question was raised that if a non-member participates in a Road Trip with our Club and has an accident, will they be covered by our NCCC insurance or just the Board Members/Club Officers? Carl will get the answer to this question. Charlie Miget indicated the NCCC insurance protects officers and board members who put on an event.
- 11. Club Dues are effective through January 1 of next year. Want to change to December 1 to correspond with due date of NCCC dues. Dues for next year will be \$55 for an eleven month period and are due in October or before the election at the November meeting.
- 12. The board decided to table donations to a particular "Charity" for this year as proceeds from the Corvettes for the Cure Car Show and the Fund Raiser Car Show for Jessica Gullet will be considered charitable donations.
- 13. A discussion was held about promoting our club by organizing a group picture to be submitted to a magazine. No decision or volunteer was named to coordinate this endeavor.
- 14. Hesslers has offered their display case at the front of the room to display a collage of all of our cars. All members are encouraged to bring a picture of their car at future meetings.
