

Raising Your C5

When raising your C5 always remember how low your car sits. You may need to drive onto a rubber mat or a 2 X 6 in order to get your car high enough to accept a jack. A C5 also require special pads to lift and for the use of jack stands, these can range from \$80. aluminum pads to inexpensive ones made from hockey pucks which are just as functional. ALWAYS place jack stands before you get under your car.

I enjoyed our phone conversation last night and am looking forward to meeting you at this year's Bloomington Gold. Enclosed is information concerning the Gold Club Package we are offering to Corvette club members

Corvette clubs that register and send payment before June 1st will be given reserved parking in the Gold Club area. Your club members will be able to park together, socialize, picnic, set up tents, and meet members from other clubs. With your registration, you will also be entitled to:

> Express entry into the show.

- Freedom to exit the grounds and still have your parking reserved.


