

Purpose of St. Louis Corvette Club:



Vettes on the Rockies, 2006

DENVER, Colorado –March 19, 2006 Looking Glass Corvette Association (LGCA) announces the schedule for the 33rd Annual Vettes on the Rockies.

Vettes on the Rockies 2006 will be held in beautiful Summit County, Colorado July 27-30, 2006. Once again, the headquarters for the event will be the Beaver Run Resort (www.BeaverRun.com) in Breckenridge, CO with events being held in various locations throughout Summit County.

Vettes on the Rockies is the premier Corvette event in Colorado and enjoys the support of General Motors (manufacturer of the Corvette), the National Corvette Museum and other nationally recognized groups who support the Corvette hobby. The annual event draws more than 500 Corvettes. Attendees in 2005 represented 35 states and two foreign countries, Puerto Rico and New Zealand. In addition to LGCA club sponsor, Purifoy Chevrolet, major event sponsors for 2006 will include Mid America Motorworks, Dragon Racing, Dreamworks, Goodyear, Corvettes Only, Coors and Coca Cola, to name a few.

Vettes on the Rockies in 2006 will include a Thursday night International buffet dinner, a Friday night sit down dinner with entertainment, and a Saturday night Dessert Bar. Activities will include a Funkana, a Road Rally, and conclude with the Show & Shine on Main Street in Frisco, CO. In 2005, representatives from the GM Corvette program made the first public announcement regarding the availability of the paddle shift transmission on 2006 Corvettes and described the extensive engineering behind the new ZO6. We expect great participation from GM again this year.
