President Announcements:

Introduction of board members made by Ray Queen and also reminded everyone to check off their names on the attendance sheet, 50/50 tickets and to check out all of the sign -up sheets for upcoming events. Ray mentioned that August was a very sad and challenging month for the club in terms of health issues for members and also the passing of Sandy Kirby. Thank-you note from Elise & Larry Akins was read. Ray thanked everyone who filled in for the board members who were absent in August.

Previous secretary minutes:




